Information about the MCCB Revised Software and Manual with Supplement

The new MCCB software now features two CDs instead of one and has been updated to expand functionality and provide additional data security options. The revised software is compatible with Windows 8 and Windows 10 as well as with previous versions of Windows.

Disc 1 – MCCB Computer Scoring Program

- Generates two composite scores: an Overall Composite based on scores from seven cognitive domains and a Neurocognitive Composite based on scores from six non-social cognitive domains. The Neurocognitive Composite allows users to distinguish between neurocognitive functioning and social cognitive functioning.
- Provides three options for calculating respondent age, allowing for age-corrected scores yet protecting patient privacy.
- Includes enhanced security features such as password protection to prevent
 unauthorized access to the program, two levels of user privileges, tracking logs to
 prevent unauthorized changes to data, and security options for exporting data as readonly and/or password protected Excel files to allow for later review or statistical
 analyses without compromising data authenticity.
- Includes two versions of the MSCEIT Branch 4 Scoring Program: the North American MSCEIT Branch 4 Scoring Program and the International MSCEIT Branch 4 Scoring Program. This allows users the option of using North American normative data or international normative data when scoring MSCEIT data. The International MSCEIT program also has new security features, including password protection, two levels of user privileges, and security options for exporting data as read-only and/or password protected Excel files.

<u>Disc 2 – CPT-IP software program</u>

• Revised to allow presentation of onscreen instructions in more than 20 languages, so respondents can view instructions in their native language before beginning the test.
