

The Rogers Criminal Responsibility Assessment Scales (R-CRAS) provides you with an empirically based approach to evaluating criminal responsibility in individuals ages 18 to 79 years, allowing you to quantify impairment at the time of the crime, to relate impairment to the appropriate legal standard, and to render an expert opinion with respect to that legal standard. Administration time varies. Available in paper and pencil.

#### Evaluate an individual's Miranda abilities through a systematic framework


The Standardized Assessment of Miranda Abilities<sup>TM</sup> (SAMA<sup>TM</sup>) is a comprehensive set of five measures that helps forensic psychologists evaluate a defendant's (ages 18 to 99 years) understanding of his or her Miranda rights. Administration time is 60 to 90 minutes. Available in paper and pencil.

## Evaluate an individual's competency to stand trial

The **Evaluation of Competency to Stand Trial**<sup>TM</sup>—**Revised (ECST**<sup>TM</sup>-**R)** is a semistructured interview designed to assess dimensions of competency to stand trial in individuals ages 18 to 79 years as propounded in *Dusky v. United States* (1960) and consistently affirmed in subsequent Supreme Court decisions. Administration time is 25 to 45 minutes. Available in paper and pencil.

## Evaluate a defendant's capacity to proceed to adjudication

The MacArthur Competence Assessment Tool–Criminal Adjudication (MacCAT-CA<sup>TM</sup>) is a 22-item structured interview for the pretrial assessment of adjudicative competence in individuals ages 18 to 80 years. Administration time is 25 to 55 minutes. Available in paper and pencil.
