

- Education history
- Everyday English usage
- Self-reported English comprehension

Administer online via PARiConnect

Rely on the convenience of digital administration in Spanish. Simply sign up for your free PARiConnect account to get started administering these tests:

- Assess impairment of executive function (EF) in children and adolescents with the Behavior Rating Inventory of Executive Function, Second Edition (BRIEF2) Parent and Self-Report Forms. Assess EF in adults who speak Spanish with the BRIEF2A.
- Assess the current frequency and severity of disruptive behaviors in home and school with the Eyberg Child Behavior Inventory (ECBI) and the Sutter-Eyberg Student Behavior Inventory-Revised (SESBI-R).
- Assess, in Spanish, emotional disturbance from the parent and student perspectives with the Emotional Disturbance Decision Tree (EDDT) and map results directly to IDEA criteria.
- Administer the gold-standard personality assessment to your Spanish-speaking clients with the PAI Spanish: Revised Translation.
- Quickly screen to evaluate at-risk areas in the parent-child system with the Parenting Stress Index, Fourth Edition Short Form (PSI-4-SF).
- Evaluate acute and chronic posttraumatic symptomatology in adults with the Trauma Symptom Inventory-2 (TSI-2).
